On 1 st September 1939 Adolf Hitler ordered Germany's forces to invade Poland. Britain and France immediately demanded that these forces be withdrawn. The demands were ignored, and on the 3 rd of September, Britain and France declared war on Germany.

The Phoney War was an early phase of World War II marked by a few military operations in Continental Europe in the months following the German invasion of Poland and preceding the Battle of France.Although the great powers of Europe had declared war on one another, neither side had yet committed to launching a significant attack, and there was relatively little fighting on the ground.

Soon after the United States entered the war, the United States, Britain, and the Soviet Union (at war with Germany since June 22, 1941) decided that their primary military effort was to be focused in Europe. Throughout 1942, British and German forces fought inconclusive back-and-forth battles across Libya and Egypt for control of the Suez Canal.

While U.S. commanders had favored a direct assault on mainland Europe, the British suggested an attack on North Africa as a way to reduce pressure on the Soviets. Moving through minimal resistance by Vichy French forces, U.S. troops consolidated their position and began heading east to attack Rommel's rear.

World War II: Fighting in North Africa and Italy

World War II began on September 1st, 1939 when Nazi Germany invaded Poland.The war in Europe began at this point and unfolded as a series of major events and battles. The first weeks of the war in Europe consisted mostly of Germany, led by Adolf Hitler, unleashing its blitzkrieg tactics against Poland. Germany used its "lighting war" strategy to quickly overwhelm and confuse enemy armies.

Causes of the American Revolution . Britain may have triumphed in the French and Indian War of 1754–1763, which was fought in North America on behalf of Anglo-American colonists but it had spent considerable sums to do so. The British government decided that the colonies of North America should contribute more to its defense and raised taxes.

At the same time that war was going on in the European and Pacific theaters, conflict also escalated in North Africa, primarily as a result of Italy's aggression in the region in 1940 and 1941. One of the primary flash points in North Africa was the key port of Tobruk . Libya, which changed hands between the Germans and the British several times and was the site of several major battles.

The European theatre of World War II was an area of heavy fighting across Europe, starting with Germany's invasion of Poland on 1 September 1939 and ending with the United States, the United Kingdom and France conquering most of Western Europe, the Soviet Union conquering most of Eastern Europe and Germany's unconditional surrender on 8 May 1945 (Victory in Europe Day).
